


You will need:

PVA glue




scissors




Instructions:




Cut out the pizza base template. Place on the cardboard and draw around




Cut out pizza base




Using the same pizza template, cut along the tomato line to make a tomato sauce template

Using the same pizza template, cut along the cheese line to make a cheese template




On yellow felt, draw around the cheese template and cut out









Cut out pepper template.
Draw around on a folded piece of green or red felt. Cut out making sure you cut through both layers




Cut out olive template.

Draw around on a folded piece of white felt in the same way as the pepper and cut out




Cut out mushroom template, draw around onto brown felt and cut out




Cut out pepperoni template, draw around onto dark red felt and cut out




Cut out three small pepperoni shapes, draw around onto white felt and cut out




Glue the three white circles onto one piece of pepperoni



Glue the tomato base to the pizza base




Glue the cheese to the pizza base on top of the tomato base




